Baptism Baptism makes us children of God and members of God's family, the Church.




Beatitudes The Beatitudes are Jesus' list of attitudes and actions that will help his followers find real happiness.

Heaven Heaven is living in happiness with God forever.


When Jesus went back to Heaven, he gave us a special helper. The Holy Spirit helps us to pray and do what is good.

Holy Week Holy Week is the week before Easter.


Jesus Jesus is God's Son. He is true God. He is also human like us. Jesus' Father is God in Heaven.
